Financial Matters:

Living expenses: The organization OMEGA will cover living expenses (full board at conference hotel) for all invited key speakers and participants for the duration of the workshop.

Speakers' Fee: Unfortunately, we can not pay a fee for speakers at the conference as our budget is limited. We are looking forward to the experts' exchange and sincerely hope that speakers may cover their work time through other projects.

Travel: The organization OMEGA will cover international travel up to the amount of 500 € for key speakers and 350 € for other participants. The organizer will make hotel bookings and reimburse you for the airline tickets upon receipt of an original ticket invoice and the boarding passes. All participants are requested to organize their travel - book flights as soon as possible to reduce costs. Participants coming by bus or train will be reimbursed for their costs upon the submission of original travel receipts. Car travel will be reimbursed at the standard rate of EUR 15 per 100 km. The organizer and participants must consider the most economical fares and means of transport.

NATO and the organizer will not take out any health or accident insurance for participants; such insurance is an individual responsibility.

Paper Submissions:

Key speakers – are requested to submit **abstracts** of their contributions in MS Word format by Feb. 28. 2011. The abstract should be between 1800 and 2000 characters with spaces. All contributions should be sent electronically to: nicola@omega-graz.at

The output of the Advanced Research Workshop may be published in the "NATO Security through Science Series". Participants are therefore invited to submit scientific articles and/or their contribution at the ARW within a month after the workshop. The articles are subject to peer review and language editing, and acceptance approval by the program committee.
